Piano accompaniment in concertos is mandatory. The application must indicate whether the applicant requests the piano accompaniment to be provided by the Slovak State Philharmonic Košice or if they will arrange their own accompanist.

Applicants may perform from sheet music.

Slovak State Philharmonic Košice offers the following:
